

### Chicago Judge Postpones Ruling on State's Attorney

CHICAGO, Dec. 13—A ruling on a motion to quash the indictment against State's Attorney Edward V. Hanrahan of Cook County was postponed today, at least until next Monday.

Criminal Court Judge Philip Romiti said he would need more time to study written arguments before reaching a decision on the case, which will affect next fall's election.

Mr. Hanrahan and 13 policemen and assistant state's attorneys are charged with conspiring to obstruct justice following a 1969 raid on a Black Panther headquarters in which two Black Panthers were killed.
