

Judge Plea Refused

CHICAGO—An Illinois Supreme Court justice yesterday turned down a plea to call in a judge from outside Chicago to try state's attorney Edward V. Hanrahan and 13 others on charges of obstructing justice in the Chicago Black Panthers case.

Justice Walter V. Schaefer repeatedly asked for precedents for the motion brought by the American Civil Liberties Union, Businessmen for the Public Interest, and the Chicago Council of Lawyers.

He then denied the motion without comment.
