ALLAN O. THOMPSON was contacted at the Rabbit's Foot Bar, 5623 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, California, at approximately 10:00 AM. He advised that he is no longer employed as manager at the St. Francis Hotel, 5533 Hollywood Boulevard. He said that he anticipates assuming the position of manager at the Morgan Hotel, 629 West 8th Street, Los Angeles, California.

THOMPSON was shown the revised artist's conception of JAMES C. HARDIN. After observing this drawing, he said that it is of excellent likeness to HARDIN as he remembered him. He said, however, that the hair in the photograph does not portray the darkness of HARDIN's hair in that it is not sufficiently dark. He said that HARDIN had very dark brown hair.

THOMPSON said that beginning July 5, 1968, that he was anticipating going to Phoenix where he will remain for approximately two weeks.
