In an effort to make contact with union people in DC in the early 1970's, "Harris" & I arranged for its lawyer to see him, Tony Bellini, Saturday morn., 10/2/71, before we returned to DC.

Sabella remembers a man of Harris' general description but not of their names who had been in front North or South Carolina and then disappeared. White, says he'd recall if he saw.

He is to talk to union people.

T.O.Jones seems to be the one to see. Several mentioned his name. I sent messages by two blacks, one a motel maid. Never had response.

Jesse Epps had been in the union then, is no, out and on his own and not doing well. Bad vibes from Chastain.
