RE: INFORMATION FROM JONES HARRIS

On October 10, 1967 JONES HARRIS advised by phone that he had heard from an unimpeachable source that CLAY SHAW and his lawyers feel that CLAY SHAW is going to be convicted in his trial. Therefore, in an attempt to avert this situation, SHAW plans to go on TV at some time prior to the trial and, even though it would be risking contempt of court, use that forum in order to make some statements (the nature of which are not known to JONES HARRIS) about his case.

JONES HARRIS further stated that LIFE Magazine have some photographs, obtained from the "Dallas Morgue" of people arrested in Dallas on the day of the assassination, which have not so far come to light.
