2 Placed Innocent of Obscenity

Two men booked with obscenity and selling without a permit pleaded innocent in Municipal Judge Andrew C. Bucaro's court today.

The men were arrested in the French Quarter yesterday after policemen saw them holding copies of the NOLA Express newspaper, the front page of which carried an illustration the officers considered obscene.

Neil Sanders, 33, 811 Esplanade, and Charles Adshire, 20, of the same address, were arrested and later released under \$1,000 bond.

Sanders was holding copies of the newspaper and standing with his juvenile son at the time of the arrest, police said. He also was charged with contributing to the delinquency of a minor.

Adshire additionally was booked with selling and exhibiting pornographic material.
