- 1. This statement is submitted in response to the Court's request for a memorandum as to the legal authority of the Central Intelligence Agency to engage in activities within the United States with respect to foreign intelligence sources.
- 2. Section 102(d) of the National Security Act of 1947, as amended, provides at Subsection (4) (50 U.S.C. \$403(d)(4)), that for "the purpose of coordinating the intelligence activities of the several Government departments and agencies in the interest of national security, it shall be the duty of the Central Intelligence Agency, under the direction of the National Security Council...to perform, for the benefit of the existing intelligence agencies, such additional services of common concern as the National Security Council...
