Lemarre has used cover name Marie Nerve, Paris phone, 876-0200.

Philippe (Philippe). Was ~~not~~ Vesjoly the name of the former French
intelligence chief or at least an agent in US? Would a picture of him be
obtainable? I could then send it to those who met others than Lemarre, the
only one I know I've met. Other Philippe: Gerinot, 30 Rue Chaptal, Levallois
92, France. In US early August 1968, October 1969, French agent named Philippe
Bouillon said to have been arrested in Manitoba for stirring up French Canadians.

Soroquerre's office 34 Ave. Kleber, Paris, has third man, 6'2", large
frame, 200 lbs., 45 years, dark hair and complexion. Height 5'5", slightly built,
brown hair, eyes, thin, long face, high forehead, prominent temples, yellow
complexion, talks little, no humor or charm, sour personality. Office plush,
tastefully 18th century decor. Another attorney upstairs there.

Late July or early August 1968, Lemarre told someone to leave word for
him at Goudart law firm in New York, and in leaving word, to use only his first
name. It is my recollection this firm has connections from the pre-World War II
era that are interesting. It should have said "aliases".
