Phillippe (Philippe). Was not Vassilip the name of the former French intelligence chief or at least an agent in US? Could a picture of him be obtainable? I could then show it to those who met others than Lemerre, the only one I know I've met. Other Phillips: Gerinnes, 33 Rue Chaptal, Levallois 92, France. In US early August 1968, October 1968, French agent named Philippe Rosillion said to have been arrested in Manitoba for stirring up French Canadians.
