By memoranda August 19, 1968, and August 18, 1969, in the captioned case, we recorded information received from the Department concerning a request by Paul L. Hoch, Berkeley, California, to see a pamphlet entitled "The Crime Against Cuba," which was obtained by Special Agent John Quigley when the latter interviewed Oswald in New Orleans in August, 1963.

On October 1, 1969, Mr. Steve Lockman of the Office of Legal Counsel in the Department called. He advised that Paul Hoch was again applying to see copies of certain pages of the original document furnished to Special Agent Quigley. Mr. Lockman inquired as to whether there would be any objection to furnishing Hoch with a copy of the material he was requesting. I told Mr. Lockman that I personally could see no objection to this but that if he wanted the Bureau's decision in this regard, he should write a letter stating his request and this would then be considered and he would be furnished with a written reply. Mr. Lockman stated he would write such a letter.
