REQUEST UNDER THE PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT
FOR RECORDS CONTAINED IN THE FILES OF THE
FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to your communication dated
October 3, 1969, captioned as above.

This Bureau interposes no objection to your
furnishing to Mr. Paul L. Hoch a Xerox copy of the entire
Corliss Lamont pamphlet "The Crime Against Cuba," which was
obtained by Special Agent John Lester Quigley from Lee Harvey
Oswald when Special Agent Quigley interviewed Oswald in
New Orleans on August 10, 1963. The pamphlet itself is in
the files of our New Orleans Office, which is preparing a
Xerox copy. This will be furnished to you as soon as it is
received from New Orleans.

It is noted that you refer in your letter of
October 3, 1969, to the "original and record copies" of the
pamphlet. The pamphlet obtained by Special Agent Quigley
from Oswald, which, as noted above, is presently in the files
of our New Orleans Office, is both the original and record
copy of the pamphlet.
