MEAN ANDUM FOR THE COMMISSION

From: J. Lee Ronlin

Assistant to the Director of the FAL, identified an FBL letter of May 4, 1964, which lists each item in the FBL like on Oswall prior to the assassing them. Mr. Belmont had the file with him and a liable to the Complesson. He preferred, however, that the file not be introduced into evidence, since some of the entries would reveal the names of confidential information or disclose secret techniques.

me Commission requested that the list of items in the file be marked to indicate whether a dreument was already in our possession, so that the Commission would only have to consider those items in the file which the Commission had not already received.

Emis has now been done in coordination with the FBI. Aviached is a copy of the FBI letter of May 4, 1964. An asterisk has been placed in the margin marking each document which the Commission does not have. The words "cover page" have been placed in the margin at each investigative report, to indicate that the Commission has received the entire report, but not the cover page. The FBI advises that the cover page is an internal administrative document which shows the routing of a report and also the names or symbols of any confidential informant relied upon in the report.

The FEI is entirely willing to make the report evailable for inspection by the Commission. The report could be made available review by each Commissioner interested in reading it, either alone with the assistance of Mr. Belmont or another FBI representative. Perhaps a better alternative would be to recall Mr. Belmont for any further testimony on the Oswald file that might be desired after call Commissioner has had an opportunity to review the file.
