RE: Contacts Between Oswald and
Cubans by Castro Elements

DATE: March 11, 1964

At page 532 of Commission Documents 75, carb
Vance Mallock relates the incident of Oswald's appearance
at the headquarters of the Cuban Student Inspector (CSI),
at which time Oswald spoke of training guerrillas to oppose
the Castro regime. Mallock said that Oswald spoke of
guerrilla operations of various types, described how easy
it would be to derail a train and mentioned that he knew
how to blow up bridges, etc.

Mallock said that Oswald mentioned that he knew
all about guns, however, ~~but~~ Mallock could not recall the
exact details of what was discussed on that subject.
Mallock said, however, that he recalled Oswald having made
some reference to Florida, but once again he could furnish
no details regarding those comments, but he did seem to
remember Oswald mentioning something to him about recently
visiting the Casa Blanca (phonetic), "a Cuban organization
in Florida." Mallock's recollection was vague regarding
further details on that matter, as was, apparently, either
his knowledge of the exact title of the Mafia (or perhaps
it was the misinformation of the FBI agent (Harrigan) that
led to this misspelling).

If the above statements can be given any credence,
which is somewhat doubtful in view of the tone of Mallock's
statement, it certainly seems to help your notions concerning
possible contacts Oswald might have had with the underworld,
or with the Cubans.
