Memorandum to file

I received today a memorandum from Mr. James J. Rowley, Chief, United States Secret Service transmitting a GUIDEBOOK FOR MARINES (SS Control #236) which was provided to the Secret Service by Dr. Carlos Bringuier at or about the end of November 1963.

The GUIDEBOOK has the name "L.H. Oswald" stamped on the fly leaf and the words "PVT. L.H. Oswald NO 1653230" in the same place.

SS Control #200, a memorandum from SAIC Rice (New Orleans) to Chief Rowley dated November 29, 1963 states that:

"On page 145 there appears considerable printed matter, apparently in a foreign language, possibly Russian, which was probably transferred from another document in reverse."

It appears, however, that the material described by SAIC Rice is actually offset print of page 146 (pressman's error). On page 189 the following words are underlined: "one minute of angle or approximately one inch on the target for each 100 yards."

Copies were made of the cover, page I through IV, and pages 145, 146 and 189.

The GUIDEBOOK was returned to Mr. Bringuier since the continued possession of the book does not appear to be necessary to any further investigation.
