If in reading my work you keep a record of what proves that Oswald did not or could not have fired a shot you may change your opinion. I have yet to get a call or a letter from any of those of whom Iwas critical complaining that I was unfair or inaccurate about him. And be did depose 4 lab agents in the Lawsuit mentioned above.

Lifton knew knew his "theory" was impossible but he got rich from it. When you get Post hortem turn to the Sibert-O'Neill report he did not give his readers.
