First, the week after I saw you I went to see my parents in Barbados for a two week stay. I took your chapters with me, but unfortunately my Mother's Monitor on her PC died and I was unable to get it fixed before I left. I did get some typing done on a friend's computer but that was inconvenient.

When I returned to the States I had a bad cold which developed into Bronchitis and that had me down for 2 weeks.
