manuscripts, documents and books, which are now in their possession

County, Maryland, or at such other location as they may designate.

2. Grantee does hereby accept the gift of the above
described materials and agrees to maintain and protect same
to the best of its ability, and to reposit same in a location
on the campus of the Grantee at a place which will be reasonably
accessible to students, scholars and the public as a whole.

3. Grantee does hereby agree to make the above des-
cribed documents accessible to the above and all other interested
parties at all reasonable times to be established by the appro-
priate policies of the Grantee.
