3rd FBI Aide Resigns After Hoover's Death

Joseph J. Casper, assistant FBI director in charge of the training division, will retire June 30, it was announced yesterday.

Casper, 53, has served in the FBI for more than 31 years. He requested the voluntary retirement for personal and health reasons.

He is the third top-ranking FBI official to retire since the death of Director J. Edgar Hoover May 2. The others are Clyde A. Tolson, 72, who was associate director, and Alex. Rosen, 66, an assistant to Hoover.
