Dear Mr. Hoover:

Thank you for your letter of February 27, 1964, in reply to mine to you of February 25, 1964 relative to the fact that pages 155 through 159 of the Clements Report dated November 30, 1963 indicate that there may be other files in the FBI on Jack Ruby.

We did not intend that the request made in our letter of February 25, 1963, be restricted to information concerning Ruby contained in the Dallas FBI files. We would like to have copies of all records of interviews with Ruby contained in all FBI records and also all copies of records of interviews of other persons, at places including Dallas, at any time, wherein Ruby is mentioned. The requests of course do not include any material obtained after November 23, 1963.
