New FBI Role

The FBI is becoming a "true national police force," George Washington University law professor Selwyn Miller says in a recently published study of the "Roles of the Attorney General of the United States."

Miller said Congress has been assigning the FBI more responsibilities and the work of the FBI has been expanding along with that of the Justice Department.
