Hoover Hits 'Anarchists' On Faculties

FBI director J. Edgar Hoover said yesterday that responsibility for maintaining campus peace and order in the coming academic year rests squarely with the college administrators.

Warning against student radicals and "rabid anarchists" among faculty staff, he said that administrators by setting guidelines of conduct, control the activities of their students.

"Let not the issue of student conduct be clouded by philosophical mouthings of self-determination, cries of repression or claims of attack against intellectual freedom," he said in the September edition of the FBI Law Enforcement Bulletin.

"College administrators must rise to face the issues honestly and then have the courage firmly to implement policies that will not permit or condone any illegitimate interruption of the educational process," he said.
