They had a couple of drinks and during the course of their conversation, told him that he had just been released from prison. then asked how much money he had and replied - \$20.00. then asked why was spending \$1.00 per drink if he only had \$20.00. stated that he wanted to know how bartenders mixed drinks in high-class bars. continued, stating that he felt had paid his debt to society and offered to buy him a meal and accepted. After leaving the hotel, they stopped at a cafe on 16th and M Streets, bought two cups of coffee and for no reason at all, said to "you're a copper" and said that he had a gun in his pocket and if he him, would shoot him. did not report the incident to the Metropolitan Police Department. stated that he was thankful that he was not shot and has hesitated to tell anyone about this, thinking no one would believe him. stated that the purpose of the call was to advise the Director that he believes is identical to the photographs of James Earl Ray and feels that Ray may possibly come back to Washington.
