
Because of the sensitivity of some of the material in this exchange (see, for example, paragraph 6 in Embassy's telegram 1201 of November 28, 1963), we will seek an understanding with the Commission that there be an opportunity to review any report which might be based on such material and which the Commission may wish to make public.
