This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther

William Bradford Huie, author, has written three articles for "Look" magazine and is currently writing a book entitled, The Slew The Dreamer." These articles and book are based on the life of James Earl Ray and the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr. We previously analyzed the three articles appearing in "Look" magazine and have written memoranda on these articles.

On April 18, 1969, William Bradford huie was interviewed by Eetty Groebli on WRC (NBC Fadio), Washington, D. C. We have recorded this interview and have analyzed it. The interview consists primarily of the same data recorded in his latest writing appearing in "Look" magazine. It essence William Bradford Huie claims that James Earl Ray and Ray alone murdered Martin Luther King, Jr., and he murdered him for recognition purposes.

1. Review the type containing the interview of William Frediced Bule by Betty Groebli and determine if any incommention is recorded thereon pertinent to this case.
