I'm tired, as I told you earlier when you poned, I don't feel right, and I'm not going to argue. You have again not does as I asked in this case and again I'm dangling, wasting more of my life. If you have done it you've not let me know. I see no end your way, so you handle the rest of this case the way you want to. I'll read the records, of course, but it is absolutely pointless to try to do anything about what they withhold or don't supply and I don't want to get upset or waste any more of the great amount of time this has wasted.

Reference is made to our letter dated July 10, 1981, concerning the Dallas Field Office file, 67-425, captioned Personnel Matters, pertaining to your request for materials on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Enclosed is additional releasable material from 67-425, and corresponding inventory worksheets, which are now considered within the scope of your request. This determination was made in conjunction with the Office of Privacy and Information Appeals (OPIA), United States Department of Justice. Sixteen of eighteen pages are being released. This material has been reviewed by the OPIA prior to release.

Where noted on the enclosed documents, excisions have been made or entire documents were withheld in order to protect materials which are exempted from disclosure by the following subsection of Title 5, United States Code, Section 552:

- (b) (6) materials contained in sensitive records such as personnel or medical files, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
