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At $5: 10 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. today I talked to SAC wisarkin relative to che ijforuv affidavit prepared by SA llosty concerning the article which appeared in the Dallas News. I told Shanlilin that the affidavit was satisfactory with the exception that it would be strengibenod if it contained a ar: sentence to the effect that Hos ty had never hoard any information $A$, ? indicating potential violence on the part of Oswald. 1 made it clear to Shanklin that this affidavit is llosty's affidavit and we do not want


Shankiin said he understood this thoroughly and that the acts are that llosty did not have any such information and, therefore, it could io in the affidavit. After checking he advised the following sentence would be inserted, "In Bact, prior to the assassination of Presicient Kennedy, I never had any information indicating potential violence on the part of Oswald." I told Shanliin to have the affidavit completed and send it to the Bureau thais afternoon.

I also advised Shankiin oi the results of Mr. Valley's contact with lir. Rankin of the Commission today, including the fact that Lt. Nevil and an Officer by the name of B.J. Dryan had submitted to the Commission affidavits along the line of the article appearing in the Dallas News, and that these affidavits were almost verbatim; that we had told dr. llankin that liosty had not macc such statements arch was submitiing an affidavit to that effect which we would give the commission.

I told dir.Shanltin that Lir. Rankin vas concerned about what appeared to be the planting of this story and possibly others in Dallas; iluat fankic was sure they had not come from the Commission, but possijiy from someone like Alexander in the District Attorney's office, and white Rankin did not want any investigation, he would appreciate any information our Dallas office picked up as to the source of this story_ Shambling said that he would iv e alert for any such information.

I also told ir. Shanklin that the Dallas MAy 5 in e should amin.. innately start dealing with the Dallas PD at arms length, and shoulcinot pi.:cipate in police training or other cooperative functions with tic: $:$ and in fact should stay away from them unless we. received informing
