Under date of March 11 you offered copies of some of James P. Hosty's original records, among them being the notes Hosty allegedly wrote the afternoon of November 22, 1963.

In my letter of two days later I asked for copies of both sides of the paper on which those allegedly original wrote were allegedly written during the Oswald interrogation.


You sent me a copy of the side on which there is the writing, exactly what was reproduced in the Hosty book.
