I would appreciate it if you could advise me as to whether the FBI processed any records on or pertaining to the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. for the House Select Committee on Assassinations which have not been processed for Mr. Harold Weisberg during the course of the above suit.

I would also appreciate it if you could send me a list of the records on Dr. King's assassination which were processed for the Select Committee which would describe those records and give the dates on which they were first made available to the Committee.

Were there any records which were processed for the Select Committee but not obtained by it? If so, could you specify these records, too? Did the FBI refuse access to any records requested by the Select Committee? If so, could you describe them?

Finally, I would like to request that you send me copies of the following two MURKIN serials as they were provided to the Select Committee on Assassinations: 1) 44-38861-5310, and 2) 44-38861-5327.
