Talked with DA in N.O .-- Howard

Kennedy assassination probe witness Lawrence Howard Jr. said Tuesday in Los Angeles after returning from New Orleans where he conferred with Dist. Alty. Jim Garrison that Garrison is a "very fine person and sincere in his investiga-tion."

"I now feel he (Garrison) is definitely on to something and the direction of his investi-gation is the right one," How-

ard added.

He added he spent four and a half hours talking with Gar-rison Tuesday "clearing up a number of things," but declined

to give details.

Howard, a 32-year-old unemrioward, a 32-year-old unem-ployed welder of El Monte, Calif., successfully fought ex-tradition to Louisiana as a ma-terial witness in the probe, but during the past week he an-nounced he'd come to New Or-

leans voluntarily.

Asked why he changed his mind, Howard said he wanted to clear his name and he felt he should help the investigation

if he could,
