On 1-3-64, this writer returned to Mrs. RUTH HYDE PAINE, eight perphlets concerning the Learne CT Women Voters of irving, ieaas, which had been insovertently taken on 12-22-63, under the assumption it was the property of MARINA OCMAIN. A receipt for this property was obtained which will be placed in the 1-A section of this file.

At this time, Mrs. FAINE volunteered the following information to this writer and SA EAED. ELL. D. ODUM:

LOINTE HUDING of the Houston "Fost" contacted her on SaturdEY, 12-20-05, at which time he stated that the FEI was foolish to deny that Agent JOSEFH HOSTI, the alleged head of the Subversive Section of the Dallas Office of the FEI, had tried to develop LEE HARVEY OSWALD as an informant. Mrs. PAINE stated she made no comment one way or the other to HUDGINS regarding this, however, she did state in the presence of both Agents that she knew SA HOSTY had not interviewed LEE HARVEY OSWALD. HUDGINS further stated, according to Mrs. PAINE, that a woman in Fort Worth had been told by Mrs. MARGUERITE OSWALD, mother of LEE OSWALD, that her son was doing secret government work. The above should be made a matter of record.
