But I've been totally consumed in battles of the affidavits with the spooks in FOIA cases and have had no time.

Yesterday they surrendered two of the three remaining Commission executive session transcripts after 10 years of stalling and I held a press conference to give them away.

Except for the purpose of the letter this updates you.

I'd been intending to call you also because I'm going to be in Baltimore for a speech in about a month. But I also forgot to get around to making that call.

With a letter in today's mail on this I'm freshly reminded. So I phoned the paper and learned you are no longer there. Hope your vacation is short.

I'm speaking at Loyola on the King assassination on 11/29. I have yet to get the details other than that it is after supper.

Until I get the specifics I'd like to know if you and Mary will be free and if we could have supper together at any decent restaurant of which you know near the college. Nice if we could - if I don't have to be at something with students, faculty or both, as sometimes happens.

and, of course, I wanted to ask you before considering any others.

Hope you are all okay. We are as we have been only a little more tired from the large amount of work all these affidavits require. Rough on Lil, who gets dirty rough-draft copy and little time for clean retyping.
