New Glomar Try To Raise Russ Sub

The new ship Glomar Explorer, built by the General Dynamics Corp., is being used to attempt to raise the Russian submarine K-129 from the bottom of the Pacific Ocean. The ship is being used by the Central Intelligence Agency to attempt to recover important equipment that might indicate the vessel's atomic capability.

The ship will rendezvous at sea with the huge barge

that it uses in salvaging work, according to City News Service.

The Glomar Explorer, last summer, was part of the Russian submarine K-129 with its huge crane, but the Central Intelligence Agency reportedly has ordered another effort to recover important equipment that might indicate the vessel's atomic capability.
