Attached herewith is one roll of 8 mm color film, furnished this date to SA ROBERT M. BARRETT, Dallas, by ROBERT J. E. HUGHES, Apartment 3, 6615 Hursey, Dallas, telephone EM 8-2751. HUGHES brought this film to Dallas Office, stating it contained some footage of the Presidential Motorcade, 11/22/63, just prior to the assassination. HUGHES took the film while standing on the southwest corner of Main and Houston Streets. The Presidential Motorcade passed in front of him, turned right, north on Houston Street, one block to Elm, then turned left. This last turn is directly in front of the Texas School Book Depository building which is shown in full in the photographs and from the photographs there appears to be a person in the sixth floor window which is the furthestest window to the right. It was from this window in this pink brick, seven floor building that the fatal shots were fired by the assassin.

The Bureau Lab is requested to enlarge each pertinent frame depicting this building and furnish ten copies of each to Dallas for identification purposes. The film also should be returned to Dallas, where it will be returned to HUGHES as per his request. It is believed that any person in this sixth floor window would be the assassin.

The Bureau Laboratory is also requested to have two copies of enclosed film made. One copy should be retained by the Bureau, the second should be returned with original, print to Dallas.

Q104 One 50' roll of 8mm Kodachrome movie film with container bearing customer's name "Robert Hughes" bearing exposures of the Texas Schoolbook Depository Building from which assassin fired the gun killing President John F. Kennedy, 11/22/63

Result of examination:

There are no images in any of the exposures of Q104 which show the corner window of the sixth floor of the Texas Schoolbook Depository Building from which the assassin's gun was fired that can be interpreted as the form of an individual. The forms recorded in this window can be interpreted as in the same general shapes of boxes, found at and just behind the window in question.

Specimen Q104 is being retained.
