Hunt, Charging Libel, Files \$3.5 Million Suit

MIAMI, May 7 (AP) — E. Howard Hunt Jr., the convicted Watergte bur-giar, filed a \$3.5 million libel suit in Federal court yesterday against Victor Marchetti, who had charged that Mr. Hunt had been involved in the assassination of President Kennedy.

Also named as a defendant was Lib-erty Lobby, publisher of a weekly, newspaper called Spotlight. Mr. Mar-chettl, who, like Mr. Hunt, is a former employee of the Central Intelligence employee of the Central Intelligence Agency, wrote the article accusing Mr. Hunt of helping to plan the 1963 assassi-nation. It was published in the Aug. 14, 1978, issue of Spotlight.

Mr. Hunt asked \$1 million in compen-nages and \$2.5 million in unages, saying, "Circula-and slanders concerning aged me economically by
