Under date of August 31, 1964, PAUL M. ROTHERMEL, JR., of the Hunt Oil Company, 700 Mercantile Bank Building, Dallas, Texas, transmitted to the Dallas Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation a two-page handwritten letter addressed to Mr. ROTHERMEL from A. L. JONES, General Delivery, Sayre, Oklahoma, dated August 25, 1964.

The following is the contents of the above-described letter:

"Mr. Paul M. Rothermel  
Dallas, Texas.

"Dear Mr. Rothermel:

"Here is how I saved Mr. H.L. Hunt's life. Last July or August I was sitting on the step at the front door entrance to the First National Bank here in Sayre and a young-man walked up to me and started a conversation. I do not remember but a small part of what he and I said in our rather long conversation, he said I have just gotten out of a Hospital and hitch-hiking my way to Amarillo, he soon began to talk about our Government and what our Government Officials in Washington stand for, and what they are doing, and he said a poor young-man does not have much chance, then I tried to encourage him to no affect, and I asked him if he drank beer, he said some-times, I said lets go have a beer, I purchased him 2-cans of beer. While he and I were in the beer bar he began
