

### **H. L. Hunt Sued For Overtime**

DALLAS, Aug. 27 (UPI) —H. L. Hunt, the oil billionaire, has been sued by a former \$150-a-week secretary for \$5,894. The secretary charged that she was worked overtime 414½ hours without being paid for it.

Juanita Beavers filed suit in U.S. District Court Wednesday. The suit named Hunt personally, Hunt Oil Co. and the Hunt radio program, Life Line.

She sued under the Fair Labor Standards Act, which provides time-and-a-half as overtime. She said that between Aug. 15, 1968, and Nov. 19, 1969, when she left the job, she had worked 414½ hours overtime without being paid.

The suit demands \$2,197 for the overtime, \$2,197 in liquidated damages and \$1,500 in lawyers' fees.
