I have just finished reading and correcting the about 60,000 words I have written on Fletcher Krotz's JFK: The CIA, Vietnam and the Plot To Assassinate John F. Kennedy, Birch Lane, 1992. It has the tentative title, The JFK Assassination: The CIA, Its "Power Elite" and Its Grand Cabal.

I may be adding a little of what I thought of while writing the conclusions. If I do it will be a selection from our correspondence.

Chip Selby is due before long with a TV crew. He is beginning to work on a sequel to his "Reasonable Doubt."
