accompanying exhibits enclosed and incorporated by reference herein. When they take these two letters and then compare these with the record as a whole, people who are truly objective will have a better understanding of how far off base you and your colleagues have been in your vicious attacks against the Warren Commission and against those of us who served with the Commission. I followed the words of Chief Justice Earl Warren that "Truth is our only goal." And that truth, Mr. Weisberg, is that Lee Harvey Oswald was the lone gunman who fired all of the shots that struck President Kennedy and Governor Connally and who fired all of the shots that struck Dallas Police Officer J. D. Tippit on that tragic afternoon in Dallas, November 22, 1963.
