

Despite Wiseman's affidavit and Dugan's loud insistence that there are no crime scene pix at one point only in one part of the index only, under Lorraine, there are 18 cards on ~~these~~ these pix. It is not possible for these cards to have been checked in Washington, not Memphis - without knowing of these many pix. These particular cards also refer to Louw's pix and the publication of some by Life. It even lists 29 exposures of aerial film, in this Washington record, originally denied to exist. There are other references to other pix called for by the request, but my point here is that there were these cards in Washington, FBI and Civil Rights both, and both Wiseman and Horn swore that there were no such pix. The false swearing could not have been more deliberate, from this one point. When I said scene of the crime the places that had to be checked certainly include where the victim was. If the index cards on that alone had been checked 18 cards of pix - and these are far from all I know of - had to show, as they did under "photos" for me. HW 1/10/77
