Dear Gary and Paul,

By now you have both received my letter to Garrison on Shaw's perjury over the rental of space and on Combs in saying Shaw left entirely voluntarily. You both have copies of CD 206;712, the interview with James Lawrence, Cross-Country Development of Bloomfield. This is one of the things I have never had time to track down. Perhaps one of you knows a trustworthy business or economics major who should be better than just an ordinary intelligent person to get me a rundown on these companies. If you do, please do not tell him why or the possible additional significance of the name Bloomfield (OSWALD IN NEW ORLEANS, from Paese Sera and possibly a French paper). Bloomfield is the name of an alleged associate in I believe Credit Mondiale or a related company. In this connection I call to your attention the extremely careful Dynond interrogation of Shaw on this, asking him only if he had ever been a direct employee of CIA, never asking if he had had any indirect connection, never asking about FBI, ONI, etc., or any fronts.

It would also be good to get all the corporate structures, including that of the ITM as far back as the beginning of 1962.

There is and has for years been a listing in the ITM of a Bloomfield, SS, company, and in the period of the FBI report, there is no listing for Room 101, that being tabulated as "vacant" when, obviously, it was not.
