On 6/26/68 SAs HOWELL S. LOWE, WILLIAM H. LAWRENCE and LT. E. H. ARKIN, Intelligence Bureau, Memphis, Tenn., PD, met with PD undercover agent code name [REDACTED]. He said that the young Invader (cell of BOP) referred to as "MONROE," appears to be in his late teens, 5' 8" tall, weighing 140 to 150 pounds, with short hair and a dark complexion, was allegedly suspended from Carver High School and may be MONROE HINDS JR., who recently went to work for the Memphis Park Commission at Riverview Park.

He said that ARTHUR NORWOOD, another young Invader, lives near Outer Parkway and Rile.

On 6/30/68 [REDACTED] advised that one associate of the Invaders is called MONROE. He calls himself MOSE MONROE DAVIS. He is a Negro male with a dark complexion, 5'7" to 8" tall, weighing 165 pounds and is in his early 20's. He lives in southwest Memphis and loafs at the Log Cabin Inn in the 200 block of South Parkway West. He associates with the Invaders but has not been seen at the apartment of JOHN B. SMITH, 1644 Hanauer, Apt. 2.
