Reference is made to memorandum dated March 3, 1969, at Memphis, Tennessee, captioned "Invaders," and previous memoranda furnished you captioned "Black Organizing Project," the name by which the Invaders was previously known.

The material furnished the Internal Security Division in this case indicates this organization promotes the idea that revolutionary action by black people in the United States is desirable. In view of this I would appreciate being advised of your decision as to possible prosecution of leaders of this organization for violations of Title 18, U. S. Code, Sections 2383, 2384 or 2385, or any other federal law within the purview of the Internal Security Division.
