SUBJECT: Activities of Invalors, 9-16-0

On 9-17-68, 0:15 AM, the informent called and stated that on 9-16-69 at 5:45 PH he observed MOTRILL MCCULLOUGH go to JOHNSON's Service Station at Florida and Elemente, at which time MCCULLOUGH stated to RICKY that he did not get to do to job and that someone had studen the can. RICKY said this was all right because he only used this can to loan it out to the Invaders.

Informat observed at 5:55 PM that MORRELL MCCULLOUGH went to 1644 Hanauer. Apt. 2, and those present were VERDELL BROOKS, ETHITT HOUSE, CHARLES HARRINGTON ERIC HOURN, UTILLE ROGERS and ROACH. NOTE: The Corvair is ROACH's brother's ear, which is in the report of July 24, 1968. Also HARRINGTON, BROOKS and HOUSE were very high.

At 6 PM informant observed MORRELL MCCULLOUGH, ERIC HOLMAN, WILLIE POGETS, FRANKLEI DAVIS and RCA CH to leave the Hansuer address and go to Howart's Antique Shop on Florida. They went there to tell HAMARD that ERIC HOLMAN would be dealing with him about the Tikis, since WILLIE ROGERS is leaving town. NOTE: WILLIE ROGI is going to college somewhere in Alchama. NOWARD at the entique shop is selling Tiki's which are solling for \$3.50. It was also learned that WILLIE WEED had take his girl friend JOYCE to the bus station for her to return to Herks, Mississippi. WILLIE ROCKERS was supposed to have left lest night, but he stated be would be coming back cach week end. The informant stated that he observed MORRELL MCCULICA buy a Tiki for \$3.50 and an Invader membership card for \$1.00 from FRIC HOWAM. ERIC stated that they have priced 1500 of these cards. The description of this card is A TWO BY TOUR CARD, BLACK IN COLOR, THE WORD INVADERS AT TOP IN RID DIE, A GOLD CRESCIPIT OR SAMED IN THE CLASTER. THE NAME IS PRINTED AT THE TOP BY ERIC HELPAN. AT THE BOTTOM OF THE CARD IT IS SIGNED BY THE CARD HOLDER AND INITIALED BY ERIC IRUNAN. High ranking Invaders, such as JOHN B. SATH, have a croscent and sword on each oide. The regular Invaders just have the sword on one side. It is noted that MORRELL MCCULLCAGH has the high ranking cord, which has the sword on both sides. This card would get you into the dances and the other activities of the Invoders. The double card would get you in free, but the wingle card is just an ID card. This card has numbers on it as, 001, 002, etc.

The informant observed at X 6:15 FM to leave HCCARD's and met WILLIE FOGERS at home, then be observed MORDELL MCCULLOUGH, FRANKLIN DAVIS, ROACH and ERIC HOUTHING to 300 W. Dison, which is ERIC's grandmother's house. They went to pick up a Tike and ID cord.

The informat observed at 6:30 PM that they went back to 1699 Henouer and those present were ETMITT HOUSE, VERDELL BROOKS, CHARLES HARRINGTON, JEWELL DAVIS and IAMBREIS DAVIS. ETMITT HOUSE got and when IRIC tried to well him the ID card. EXMITT stated, "You could give me a card, since every piece of money I get goes into the organization." He also stated that he had left his wife and four kids for the organization. HARRINGTON and EROOKS stated that he should give them a car since they don't have a job. IMPRINGTON also stated that GENALD FARIOR was going to try to send all the guys to college in January that wanted to go.

-Poge 2 - A ctivities o Quivaders, 9-16-68.

At 5,45 PM the informant observed JOHRNY FRIERSON and two unknown sale coloreds come to the apartment. The first male colored, 24 years old 200 lbs., 5'10" large Airo hair, and medium complexion. No. 2 male colored, 2. 5'8". 160 lbs., medium Airo hair do, dark completed. FRIERSON and No. 1 mle colored had on GI hoots. They came in a dark green thistang. FRIERSON wanted to see one of the invader's cords and wanted to know who printed it. ERIC would not tell his but ERIC stated that it would be impossible to duplicate the eard because to has the plates. NOTE: The informant will try to find where this cord is being printed.

At 7 PM informent observed MORDELL MCCULLOUGH, ETHIT HOUSE, VERDILL BROOKS and CHERLES HARDINGTON go to HOUSE's mister-in-low's house on Philser to an apartment in the 2000 block area. They picked up a bundle of ciothing andthen returned back to 1644 Hannuer:

At 7:30 PM the informent observed MCCULLOUGH, HOUSE, BROCKS and HARRINGTON go to Micsissippi and Valker Zlooking for a pusher of carijuana by the name of MACCETT, but did not find him. Then they went to WILLIAMS off of Mississippi, ballway in the black, a big white bouse which sits back off of the street. HOUSE and MARRINGTON cent up to the door, but they still dednot get anything, then they were observed to go to Leibyne College at the gym where they were procticing basket ball. HOUSE gaked the conch for MACCETT, NOTE: It is possible that he is a player for the basket ball team, but he was in the dressing room at this time a they went to the dressing room, but he did not hope snything.

The informant observed at 7:45 PM. HOUSE, HARRINGTON, BROOKS and MCCULLOUGH go back to Micrissippi and Malker and HOUSE went into the pool room and bought a five dellar beg of carijuana, but it is unknown whohe bought it iron. They were observed riding around, sooking the marijuana. NOTE: The informant has a reach which is seen carijuana, which will be picked up at a later date.

At 9:00 PM the informant observed ACCULLOUGH, MARRIANGTON and BROOKS TO let MCCSE off at the Playboy Villa, since he did not want to see the football gas on television.

At 9:15 FM the informent observed BROOKS, MARRINGTON and MCCULLOUGH go to McLerore and Leuderdol e to MARRINGTON's uncle's house, which is Apt. 10 of the sportments of the northeast corner of Leuderdole and McLerore. There they watche the ball game until the helf, then they went to MARRINGTON's sunt's house on McKeller to watch the rest of the ball game.

At 11:30 FM the informent observed MCCULLOUGH take MARRINGTON home and BROCKS to 1644 Hanguer. MOTE: Intilly House sold he was going to Chicago when the trial is over. It was also learned that they are supposed to be out of the 1644 Hanguer address by Wednesday.
