He advised the Negro people of Memphis do not like Mayor HENRY LOEB's stand in this strike, and they do not believe the mayor is giving them a fair shake. On each date of contact, source advised he did not foresee any violence as a result of the strike and if any violence did occur, it would be the result of action by young Negroes and teenagers who do not follow the old Negroes regarding better living conditions, working conditions, and social

He stated he knows of no group that would be in a position to organize violence in Memphis. On 3/27/68, source advised he did not foresee any trouble with respect to the strikers' march for freedom being led by Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. He knows of no organized activity with respect to the march. He advised that if violence of any nature is pending, he would immediately contact the writer.
