On 0:00 a.m. Saturday, 3/30/68, called SA HOWELL S. LOWE to say that he had just observed several uniformed officers of the Memphis PD arrest CHARLES STEVEN BALLARD (who on 2/10/68 volunteered to SAS LOWE and LAWRENCE that he is a member of the Black Organizing Power - BOP - affiliate of SNCC in Memphis). This was at 1830 Kansas. had no idea why PALLARD was arrested.

At 10:15 a.m. Lt. GEORGE FEATHERS, Inspectional Bureau, Momphis PD, advised that RALLARD was affected on a state warrant charging BALLARD with disorderly conduct sworn out by Officer H. B. DOWLING, Nemphis PD. DALLARD after his arrest made one phone call to WILLIE LESTER at # 525-4250 (Criss Cross and 1967 city directory show this number is listed for KOLLY B. MATTHEWS, 1098 Clyde St., and also for Matthews Beauty Shop).

SAS LORE and ROBERT F. BOYLE later interviewed BALLARD and the results are being set forth in a separate communication.
