

Companion's Death Brings Prison Term

A man identified as a member of the militant Invaders was sentenced to one to five years in prison in Criminal Court yesterday in the fatal shooting of another Invader.

Albert Frison, 21, of 179 First Avenue said a companion, Anthony Warren, 21, of 56 East Fernwood was shot accidentally when Frison passed a pistol to him. Warren was killed Jan. 28 when he, Frison and two other men were driving late at night on Highway 51 South near the Whitehaven Shopping Center.

Warren's body was found the next morning off Weaver Road between Harahan and Cypress Creek.

Frison pleaded guilty to involuntary manslaughter. Asst. Atty. Gen. Terry Lafferty told the court the evidence showed Frison, riding in the front seat, became frightened at the approach of a patrol car from the sheriff's office and handed a 38-caliber revolver to Warren, in the rear seat, telling him to hide it. In the transfer the pistol discharged, shooting Warren through the heart.
