IN CONNECTION WITH INFORMATION SET FORTH IN RETEL REGARDING RHODESIA, BUREAU ATTENTION DIRECTED TO SIMILAR COMMENTS RE RHODESIA AS REPORTED BY BROTHER JOHN LARRY RAY IN ST. LOUIS TEL OF MAY NINE PAST.

BUREAU REQUESTED TO ADVISE LEGAT, CANADA, OF POSSIBILITY SUBJECT JAMES EARL RAY MAY HAVE SECURED CANADIAN PAPERS IN ORDER TO DEPART CANADA FOR RHODESIA. REQUEST LEGAT, CANADA, BE INSTRUCTED RECHECK APPROPRIATE CANADIAN AGENCY FOR POSSIBLE INFORMATION RE ISSUANCE OF PASSPORT OR OTHER NECESSARY PAPERS FOR ALLEGED CANADIAN CITIZEN TO DEPART CANADA FOR RHODESIA.

THIS WOULD INCLUDE CHECK TO ASCERTAIN WHETHER OR NOT SUBJECT UNDER HIS OWN NAME OR ANY KNOWN ALIASES MAY HAVE SECURED CANADIAN CITIZENSHIP. IN ADDITION, LEGAT, CANADA, SHOULD BE INSTRUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT FLIGHTS ARE AVAILABLE, IF ANY, WHEREBY PERSON DEPARTING FROM MONTREAL OR TORONTO MIGHT GET TO RHODESIA.

IN CONNECTION WITH INQUIRIES BUREAU WILL RAISE WITH RHODESIA REPRESENTATIVES, SUGGEST THAT BUREAU DETERMINE IF POSSIBLE NUMBER AND IDENTITY OF ALL ENGLISH SPEAKING IMMIGRANTS TO RHODESIA IN PERIOD FROM APRIL FIVE LAST TO DATE. ENGLISH SPEAKING IMMIGRANTS SHOULD BE RESTRICTED TO U.S. AND CANADA AT THIS TIME.
