DR. JERRY T. FRANCISCO, MEDICAL EXAMINER, UNIVERSITY OF TENN., AT MEMPHIS, ADVISED THAT AN AUTOPSY WAS PERFORMED ON DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., ON THE NIGHT OF APRIL FOUR, LAST.

AVAILABLE APRIL SIXTEEN, WEXT. DR. FRANCISCO FURWISHED
THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CONCERNING HIS FINDINGS AT THE
TIME OF THE AUTOPSY:



THE MISSILE ENTERED THE RIGHT JAW OF DR. KING, SIXTYONE
INCHES SUPERIOR TO THE RIGHT HEEL. THIS IS A POINT FIFTYWINE INCHES SUPERIOR TO THE RIGHT HEEL AWITH THE HEAD
POSITIONED TO CORRESPOND WITH THE PATH OF THE MISSILE.

THE MISSILE SEVERED THE SPINAL CORD AND CAME TO REST BENEATH
REC 11 / 3 / 7

THE SKIN FIFTYFIVE AND ONE HALF INCHES SUPERIOR TO THE
LEFT HEEL AND THREE INCHES TO THE POINT OF ENTRY, TO THE
FINAL RESTING POINT OF THE MISSILE WAS EIGHT AND ONE HALF INCHES.

DR. FRANCISCO SUMMARIZED THE ABOVE STATEMENT BY

COMING TO REST AT A POINT JUST BENEATH THE SKIN THREE INCHES

TO THE LEFT OF DR. KING'S BACKBONE. DR. FRANCISCO STATED THAT

HE SIGNED THE DEATH CERTIFICATE INDICATING THE OFFICIAL CAUSE

OF DEATH TO BE GUN SHOT WOUND TO THORASIC CORD. THE DEATH

CERTIFICATE WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM DEPT. OF HEALTH ON APRIL

SIXTEEN, NEXT. ON APRIL SIXTEEN, NEXT, A COPY OF THE AUTOPSY AND

DEATH CERTIFICATE WILL BE OBTAINED BY MEMPHIS DIVISION.

MR. PAUL E. HASS, ASST. ADMINISTRATOR, ST. JOSEPH'S
HOSPITAL, MEMPHIS, ADVISED THAT MR. J. L. LUTON, ASSOCIATE
ADMINISTRATOR OF HOSPITAL, HAS MAINTAINED ALL HOSPITAL RECORDS
