There are enclosed two copies of a memorandum dated # 942
May 7, 1964, captioned "Marilyn Dorothea Murret."

Miss Murret is a cousin of Lee Harvey Oswald, her
mother being a sister of Oswald's mother. She was interviewed
on November 29, 1963, and advised she took a trip around the
world beginning in July, 1959, and ending in January, 1963.

1963, concerning Lee Harvey Oswald, page 162.)

The Harold Isaacs mentioned in paragraph four of page
one of the enclosed memorandum may be identical with
Harold Robert Isaacs who, in 1958, was employed at the Center
for International Studies, Massachusetts Institute of Technology,
Cambridge, Massachusetts.
