DEVELOPMENT: Jay Iselin called Wick late last evening, stating that Buchanan was to come back to Washington Thursday, 3-12-64, to see New Republic" representatives for the purpose of writing an article in that magazine on the involvement of Oswaldiand Ruby with the FBI. Iselin said he did not know whether Buchanan had, in fact, returned to Washington. Iselin said it was Monday, 3-9-64, that he had talked with Buchanan. It was Tuesday, 3-10-64, said Iselin, that Buchanan had talked with Deputy Attorney General Katzenbach. During the discussion with Katzenbach, the latter arranged for Buchanan to see Howard Willens of the Warren Commission. Iselin said he believed that Mr. Katzenbach phoned Willens asking him to see Buchanan.
